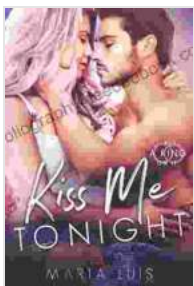


An Enemies to Lovers Sports Romance That Will Sweep You Off Your Feet: Put Ring On It

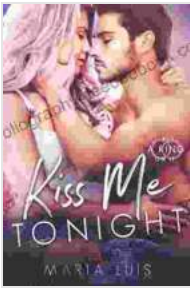

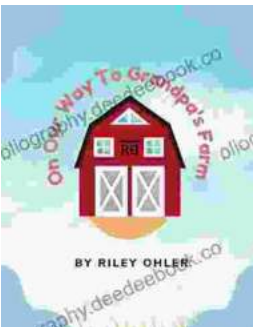

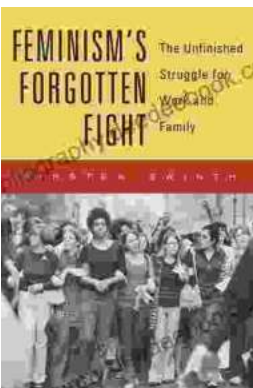
