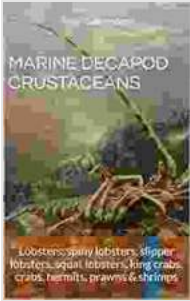

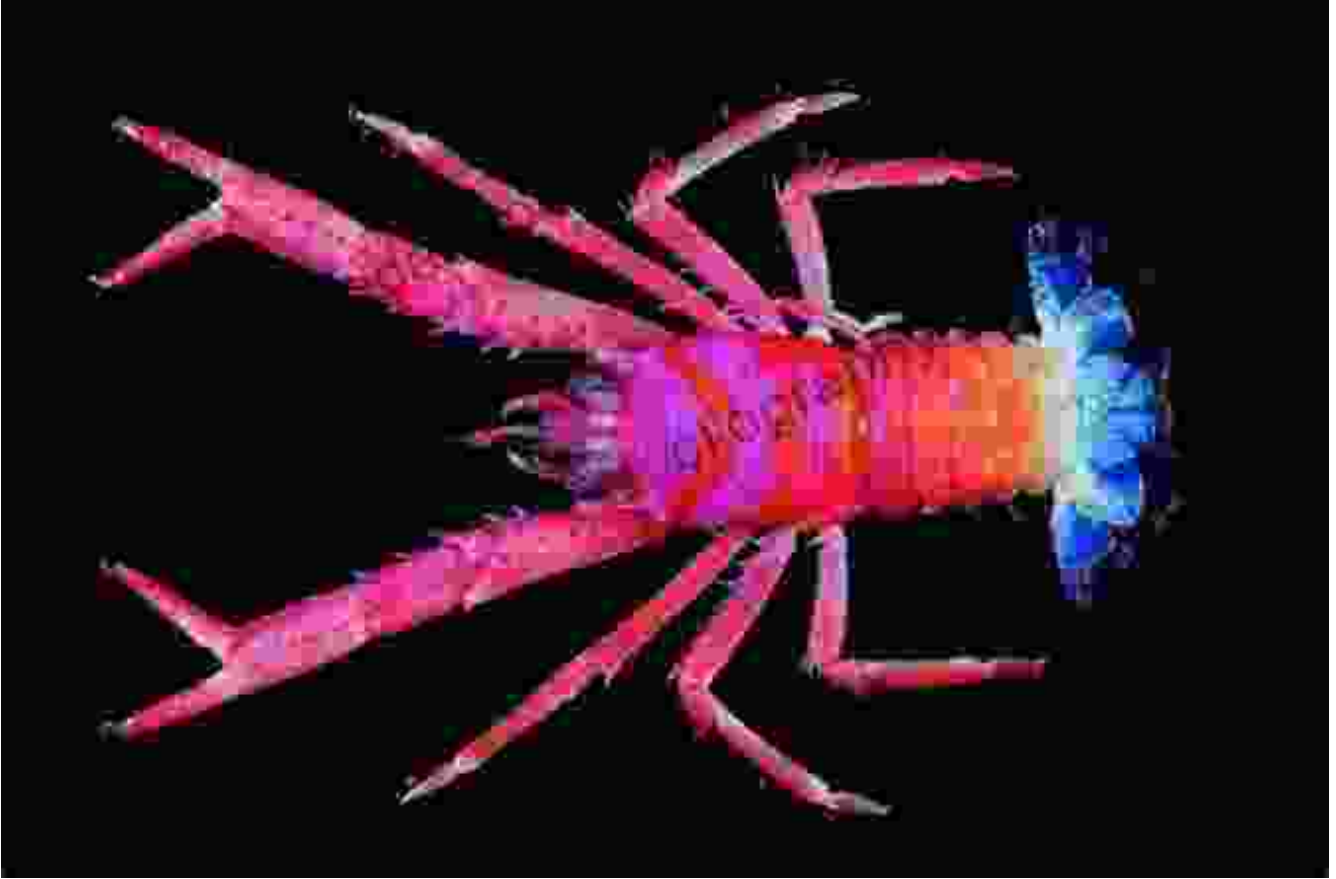
Slipper Lobsters

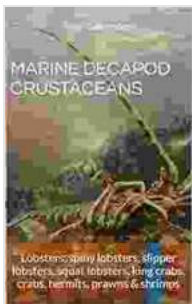

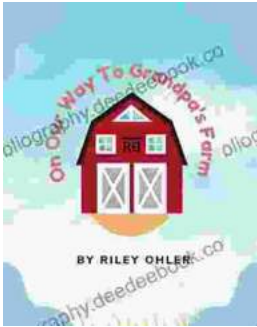

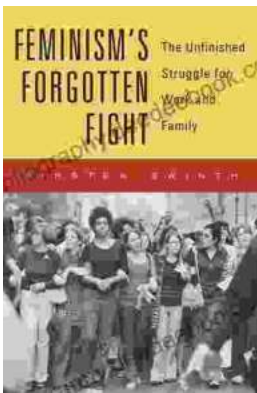
