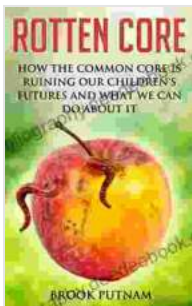
Here are some of the ways that the Common Core is harming our children:

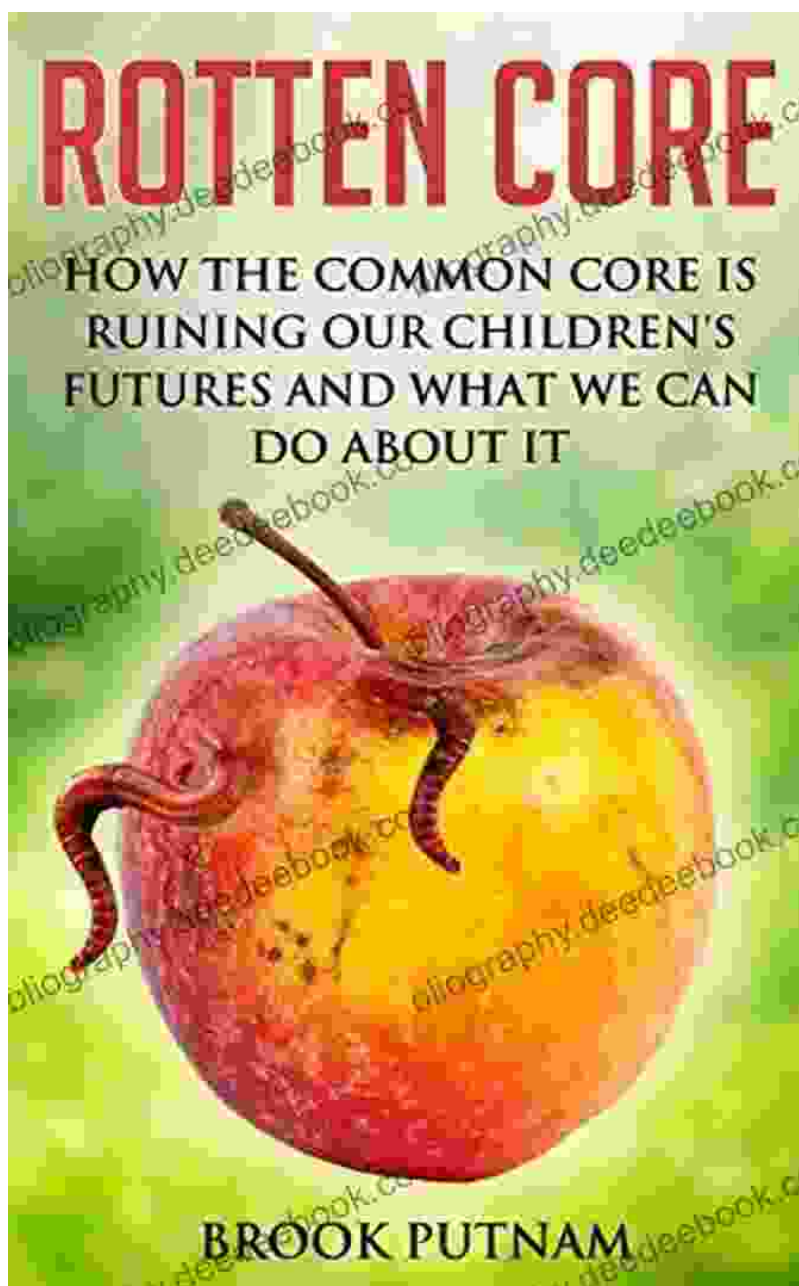
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- **Contact your elected officials.** Let them know that you are concerned about the Common Core and that you want them to take action to stop it.

The Common Core is a serious threat to our children's future. We need to take action now to stop it.

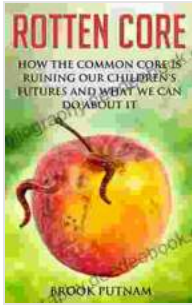


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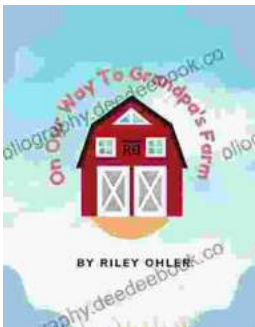
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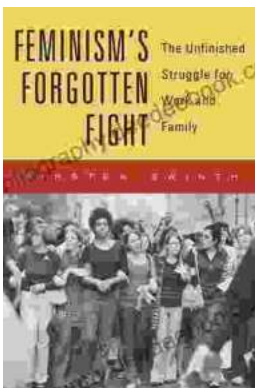


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
