

Design

The Pizazz features a sleek and stylish design with a premium glass and metal construction. Its slim profile and curved edges make it comfortable to hold and operate. Display

Both the Pizazz and The New Kid feature large and vibrant displays, but there are some key differences between the two. The Pizazz sports a 6.4-inch Super AMOLED display with a resolution of 2340 x 1080 pixels. It offers excellent color accuracy, deep blacks, and wide viewing angles. The New Kid, on the other hand, has a slightly larger 6.5-inch IPS LCD display with a resolution of 2400 x 1080 pixels. While it does not match the color accuracy and contrast of the Super AMOLED display, it is still a very good display with good brightness levels and viewing angles.

Performance

Under the hood, the Pizazz is powered by the latest Snapdragon 8 Gen 1 processor, which is one of the most powerful mobile processors currently available. It is paired with 8GB of RAM and 256GB of internal storage. The New Kid, on the other hand, is powered by the MediaTek Dimensity 1200

processor, which is also a very capable processor but slightly less powerful than the Snapdragon 8 Gen 1. It is paired with 6GB of RAM and 128GB of internal storage.

In terms of performance, the Pizazz has a slight edge over The New Kid, especially in demanding tasks such as gaming and video editing. However, both devices offer smooth and responsive performance for everyday tasks such as browsing the web, checking email, and using social media.

Camera

The camera is one of the most important features of a smartphone, and both the Pizazz and The New Kid offer impressive camera systems. The Pizazz has a triple rear camera setup consisting of a 50MP main camera, a 12MP ultrawide camera, and a 5MP macro camera. 
