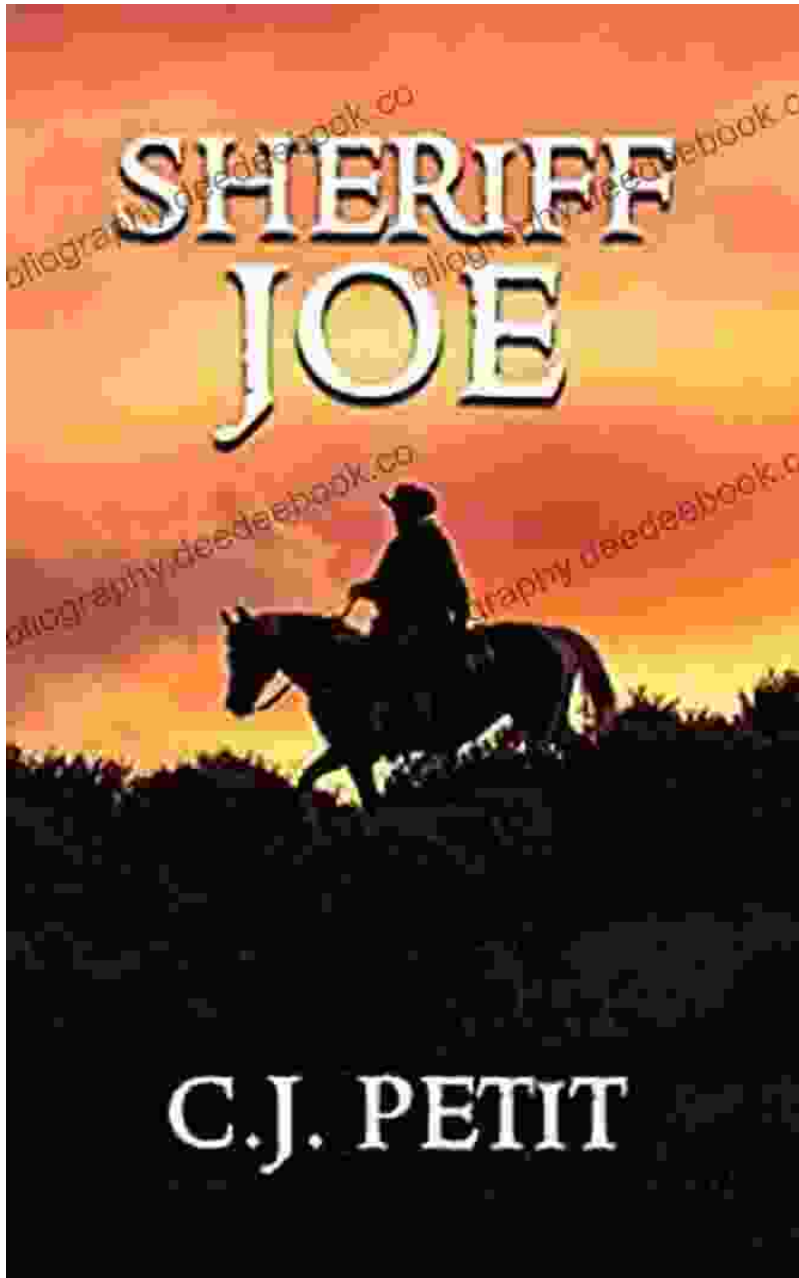

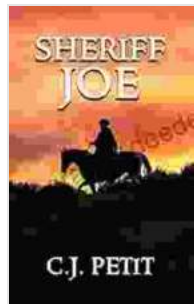


Early Life and Career

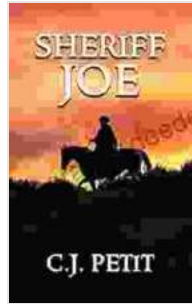

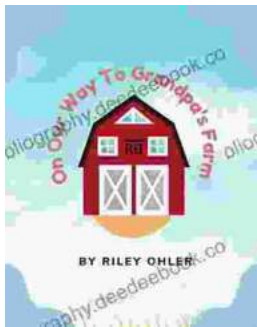

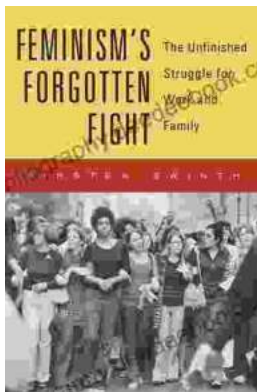
