through thick and thin. And they always remembered the little girl who saved them from the mud.

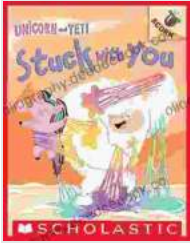

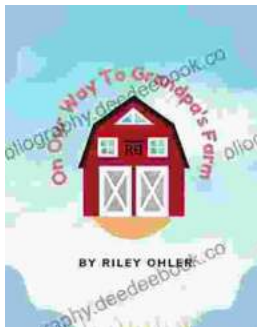

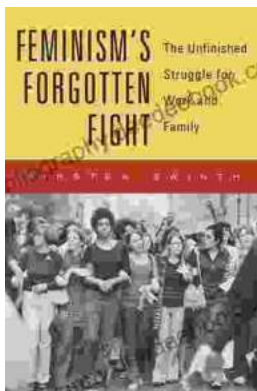
