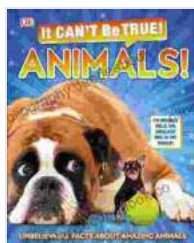

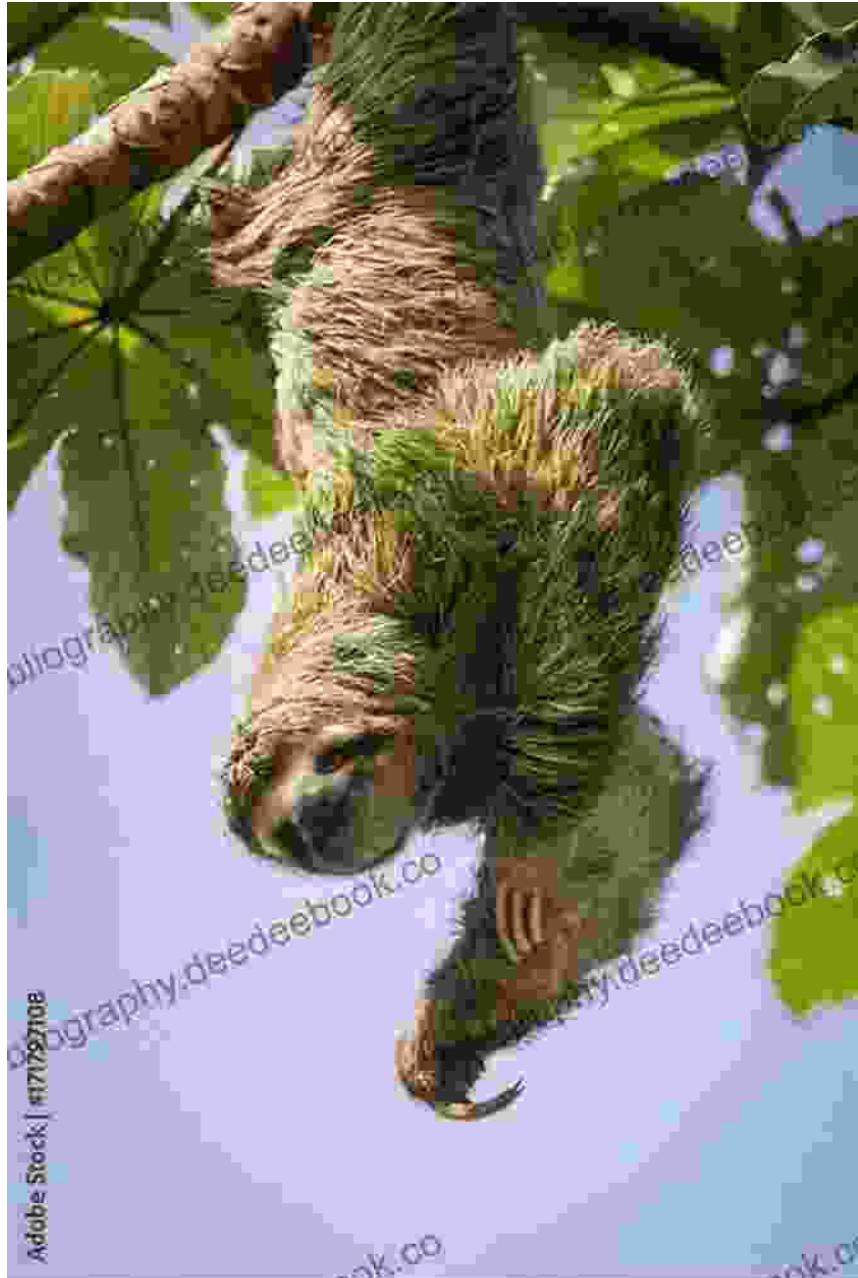
### 1. The Mantis Shrimp Can Punch With the Force of a .22 Caliber Bullet

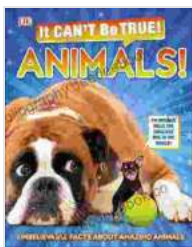

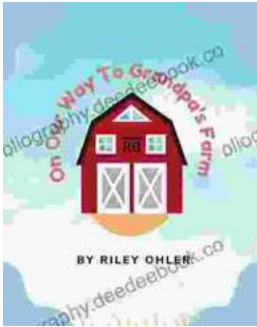

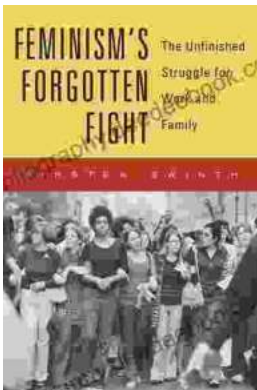
